### **Honor Award Categories:**

#### 1. Medal of Honor

This award recognizes an AIA member who has at least 15 years of experience demonstrating the most distinguished service to the chapter, community, and the profession of architecture. The award is limited to one person per year and one time per person. Sitting board members of the Florida Gulf Coast Chapter are eligible. The award is not required to be given if the jury feels there is not a suitable recipient.

#### 2. Builder of the Year

This award recognizes a licensed general contractor who has exemplified a sincere and genuine interest in encouraging and affecting outstanding craftsmanship and workmanship in the performance of work on a specific project. Any company licensed in Florida who has fulfilled the intent and purpose of this award may be nominated. In order to recognize the talent in our area, the immediate past recipient is ineligible.

#### 3. Champion of Architecture

A layperson, academician or non-governmental organization that has given outstanding support to the architectural profession, helping to raise the awareness. Any person who is not an architect, fulfilling the purpose of this award as described, is eligible.

Each nomination shall contain:

1. A completed form.
2. A nomination letter by the sponsor explaining the candidates' qualifications and not to exceed one page.
3. A biography of the candidate not to exceed two pages.
4. A statement of contribution not to exceed four pages.
5. Supporting material (e.g. clippings, articles, etc. relating to the purpose of the award) not to exceed four pages.
6. A minimum of three and maximum of six letters of support not to exceed one page each (letters should be explicit in their recommendation and contain specific reasons for support).
